Footnotes

RED SHARP HUMOR dueled outside a rival then between horses early on the second turn, fought back on a short lead off the rail leaving that turn and through the stretch and held on gamely under urging. MIDNIGHT INTERLUDE chased between horses then stalked outside a rival, bid three deep into the second turn then outside the winner leaving that turn and through a long drive and continued willingly to the wire. BALLADRY stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horse into and on the second turn, came out off the fence leaving the turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. LE MANS four wide into the first turn, angled in and chased off the rail, found the inside leaving the backstretch, went around a rival leaving the second turn, angled to the inside again and was edged for third. BIG BUSINESS stalked three deep then off the rail, went up three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. TAPAWAY a bit slow to begin, pulled his way along just off the rail and steadied into the first turn, chased a bit off the fence, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MORENO STAR broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled outside a rival then off the inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. INDIAN KNIGHT had speed between horses then angled in and dueled inside, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
