TITIAN prompted the pace outside a rival, took the lead nearing the quarter pole, inched away into the stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging while bumping with the runner-up on the line. LORO pulled his way along three deep between horses then stalked off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the winner past midstretch but could not get by while bumping with that one late. SUNDAY HEADLINE four wide early, angled in and stalked off the rail or outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and just held third. WARRENS WILD THING settled outside a rival, moved up three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and just missed the show. UZZIAH between horses early, steadied in tight off heels nearing the first turn, saved ground, went around a foe into the second turn, angled back in, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SEEK THE LIGHT chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. THE FLYING WHIZZER sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back leaving the second turn, then weakened. SPICY BEAU saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back in a bit close off heels leaving the backstretch and gave way.
