Footnotes

SMART SPENDING settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and rallied under urging to split foes four wide in late stretch and got up. SAHARA SKY unhurried outside off the rail or outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and closed willingly five wide on the line. LUCKARACK chased outside or off the fence, came out four wide into the stretch, bid between horses past midstretch and continued willingly. INDIAN WINTER stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, split horses past the eighth pole and rallied between rivals late. BATTI MAN (ARG) dueled outside a rival, inched away a half mile out, angled in on the turn, fought back along the fence in the stretch and was outfinished. CLOSE TO THE EDGE stalked outside then alongside a rival, bid three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch then outside a foe in midstretch and weakened between horses. SADDLERANCH went up inside to duel for the lead, stalked a bit off the rail into the turn, re-bid between horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DETAILS R SKETCHY dropped back outside then off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground, came out while being pulled up into the stretch and was vanned off. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
