**Footnotes**

TONES (IRE) went up between horses to press the pace then stalked off the rail, bid again into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, drifted out despite right handed urging and held on gamely. STONEY FLEECE chased off the rail, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. PASSING GAME settled just off the rail then inside on the hill, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and finished gamely between horses while drifting in slightly in the final strides. SMOKING G sped to the early lead off the rail then dueled three deep, stalked outside a rival leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch, re-bid outside foes past midstretch and steadied in tight off heels between horses on the line. COACH BOB went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the hill and set the pace inside, fought back when challenged again in the stretch and was outfinished late. BRIGAND broke in and steadied briefly, tugged his way along to stalk the pace off the rail then inside on the hill and into the stretch, waited some behind foes in midstretch, came a bit off the fence and could not offer the necessary late response. LOUKAS (IRE) allowed to settle a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and made up some ground but was not a serious threat. MAJOR MAGIC chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
