FORTIFIER settled off the inside, moved up outside leaving the turn and six wide into the stretch and rallied under some urging and steady handling to prove best. PERFORMING MAGIC saved ground, began to advance leaving the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and picked up the place late. JOOPY DOOPY was taken back from between horses early and chased the leader three deep on the backstretch and turn, bid outside that one in the stretch, could not match the winner late and just lost second. SIGN OF FIRE angled in unhurried early, came out a bit into the stretch, went around a rival in deep stretch and put in a rail rally late. GIBSON COUNTY sped to the early lead, got clear and angled in on the backstretch, fought back when challenged in the stretch, then weakened some late and was outfinished for a minor award. HERE'S ZEALOUS chased the leader along the inside on the backstretch and turn and had little left in the final furlong. PURELY COZZENE allowed to settle toward the inside, went outside a rival on the turn and did not rally. DANCE MASTER was in a good position tracking the leader between foes on the backstretch and turn, swung five wide into the stretch and gave way.
