Footnotes

GOOD ACKTRESS raced between horses into the first turn, eased back around the turn to find a comfortable stalking position behind the pacesetters, came into the second turn just off the rail, moved up around the turn on the wood to take the lead nearing the quarter pole and drew away under urging through the stretch drive. TOSCANOVA was hustled to the lead into the first turn, maintained the advantage down the backstretch while off the rail, relinquished the lead nearing the quarter pole, drifted out slightly while between horses entering the stretch, weakened through the final furlong while inside SILVER LUNA and edged that one for the place. SILVER LUNA broke out slightly at the start, raced three deep around the first turn, stalked outside the pacesetter down the backstretch, was again three wide on the second turn, came into the lane three wide, was bumped at the three sixteenths pole and lost the battle for the place in the late stages. REAL ROCKPORT chased three wide down the backstretch and around the second turn, came into the stretch four wide, was bumped in upper stretch, remained outside through the drive and was edged for the show. LOVE YOU SO chased off the rail to the lane and could not make up the needed ground in the lane. ONE BYE ONE saved ground around the first turn, chased inside a rival down the backstretch, began to weaken on the second turn and fell back through the stretch drive.
