QUICK ENOUGH sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, dueled from the rail leaving the hill, fought back inside through the stretch and gamely prevailed under good handling. AMAZOMBIE stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the winner leaving the hill, reached even terms in upper stretch, fought back through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. DANCING IN SILKS pulled his way along to stalk the pace off the rail then inside on the hill, came out a bit into the stretch and held third. EARNEDNEVERGIVEN chased four wide then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished for the show. HOT DAMON settled off the inside then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. CAYAMBE was in a good position stalking the pace off the inside to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COLGAN'S CHIP squeezed back just after the start, settled off the inside then along the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. J P JAMMER saved ground off the pace to the stretch, remained inside in the drive and did not rally. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
