LA SORPRESA (ARG) pulled her way along to stalk the pace outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, drifted inward in deep stretch but held on gamely under left handed urging. TOP SPINNER (NZ) chased inside then a bit off the rail, went up three deep on the second turn, bid four wide leaving that bend, also shifted in some in the final furlong but continued willingly between foes late. SWEET FRIPPERY saved ground stalking the pace, awaited room toward the inside leaving the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch, was blocked behind foes until just past the sixteenth pole, came out and finished well. OUR FLING (NZ) three deep early, stalked then forced the pace outside a rival, battled between foes leaving the second turn and to deep stretch and weakened late. TREBIA (CHI) sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back leaving the second turn and in the stretch but also weakened some late. KISSING GIRL (ARG) pulled early, chased a bit off the rail, waited behind foes midway on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MINAMALA (IRE) off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally.
