Footnotes

THE PAMPLEMOUSSE had speed between horses then set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and drew off under a left handed tap of the whip and a steady hand ride. TAKE THE POINTS angled in and stalked the pace three deep then off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. MR. HOT STUFF allowed to settle outside a rival, angled in on the second turn and gained the show inside. BOURBON BAY chased outside a rival then between foes, continued off the rail leaving the backstretch, swung out into the stretch and was edged for third. UNBRIDLED ROMAN settled outside then three deep, continued alongside a rival on the second turn, came out three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SMART BID angled in and stalked the pace inside, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. MARK S THE COOLER also angled in and stalked between horses to the second turn and also weakened. HI FLYIN INDY saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. TIZ TRUE chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. BALFOUR PARK unhurried while saving ground to the second turn, came outside a rival into the stretch and failed to menace.
