COMPARI pulled a bit and sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, inched away on the second turn and drew clear in the stretch under some urging and good handling. ENRICHED chased outside a rival, moved up three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. SWIFT WINDS chased just off the rail then inside, moved up leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, was in a bit tight midway on that turn, came out some into the stretch and just missed second. KALOOKAN STORM chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses into the second turn, steadied off heels midway on that turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LIBERIAN FREIGHTER stalked just off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, bobbled on the second turn while outside foes and could not offer the necessary late response. LIVE SUNDAYS pulled his way along to stalk inside then a bit off the rail, bobbled early on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. JACK'S WILD angled in and settled off the pace inside then just out from the rail, angled out into the stretch and did not rally.
