Footnotes

WARREN'S DR. BOO had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away in upper stretch, drifted out despite right handed urging and held. KURO bumped in a bit of a slow start, angled in and chased inside, moved up along the rail into the stretch and through the drive and edged rivals for the place. HIDDEN BLESSING bumped at the break, moved up between foes then chased a bit off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and was edged for second. VAUNDELL stalked outside on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. SECRET JACKPOT settled outside then off the rail, split foes three deep into the stretch and found his best stride late. LONE JUSTICE chased outside then off the

rail, angled in some on the turn, drifted to the inside in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. JEFFREY'S GROOVE had speed three deep then stalked a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. DANCE WITH GABLE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, found the inside on the turn and could not summon the necessary response in the drive. SOLAR ROCKET had speed between horses then dueled outside the winner, dropped back in the stretch and weakened. MAX COOPER chased between horses, split rivals again on the turn and did not rally. USURP bobbed at the start, settled outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. LUCKY AND TOUGH hopped, bumped a rival and steadied in a slow, awkward start, dropped well back off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was outrun.
