Footnotes

SKYSPY prompted the pace five wide then stalked four wide on the turn and into the stretch, bid again four wide in midstretch, gained a short lead under some urging in deep stretch and proved best. BYJOHN chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, awaited room off heels in midstretch, angled out and gained the place late three deep on the line. HIGH INTELLECT dueled between horses then stalked between foes on the turn, split rivals with a bid in midstretch and held third. SCOTT'S POPPY had good early speed a bit off the rail then dueled between foes, stalked inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, re-bid between horses in midstretch and was outfinished. TRANSVAAL SCOTTISH stalked outside then alongside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. KINDACATCHY went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the turn, fought back to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. STALEMATE steadied when squeezed at the start, settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted in and was not a threat. PERFECTLY SANE prompted the pace four wide between horses then stalked three deep between foes on the turn and weakened in the drive.
