RED VINTAGE (GB) unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and closed gamely under urging to get up at the wire. POHAVE stalked along the inside, came out into the stretch and rallied late between foes to share the place. VODKA AND TONIC prompted the pace inside then stalked into the turn, bid again on the bend and took a short lead, shook clear into the stretch and held gamely but was caught late. VRONSKY bobbled at the start, dueled three deep then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, continued three wide on the turn, angled in some into the stretch and weakened. DISTINCTION had good early speed and vied for command between horses then off the rail leaving the backstretch, battled between foes again on the turn, also angled in entering the stretch and weakened. T.J. DIAMOND was in a good position stalking the leaders three deep on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. HURRICANE SMOKE pulled hard between rivals while drifting out on the backstretch, stalked off the rail into the turn, continued outside a rival and three deep into the stretch and had little left. THUNDERMANN (AUS) a bit crowded at the start, chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally.
