Footnotes

MILWAUKEE BREW close up outside early, went up three deep to prompt the pace on the first turn and backstretch, battled outside CONGAREE on the second turn and into the stretch, put a head in front past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. CONGAREE stalked early, bid between horses into the first turn and duelled for command, took a short lead into the second turn, angled in and battled inside the winner, fought back gamely through a long hard drive and continued willingly to the wire. KUDOS pulled between horses early, came out into the first turn, chased outside, went three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. PLEASANTLY PERFECT also between horses early, chased outside or off the rail, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PIENSA SONANDO (CHI) chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses on the second turn, angled in and could not offer the necessary response. TROMPOLINO (CHI) sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, dropped back on the second turn, drifted out in the stretch and gave way.
