Footnotes

HEATSEEKER (IRE) settled between horses then off the rail chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside the pacesetter in the drive, took the lead past the eighth pole, kicked clear under left handed urging and held gamely. GO BETWEEN also chased outside then three deep on the first turn, continued alongside a rival on the backstretch and off the rail on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and closed willingly. CHAMPS ELYSEES (GB) broke slowly, settled inside then off the rail, came out into the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch, angled in and gained the show late inside. TIAGO broke a bit slowly, lagged back toward the inside then a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and just missed third. ZAPPA chased between horses then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STUDENT COUNCIL stalked the pace off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the second turn and between foes into the stretch and lacked a further response. AWESOME GEM unhurried inside then off the rail into the backstretch, went outside leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. GREAT HUNTER chased outside then alongside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. AIR COMMANDER broke outward and a bit slowly, angled in and stalked off the rail

then inside on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. BIG BOOSTER allowed to settle off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. SEMINOLE NATIVE unhurried early, chased between horses, came out in the stretch and was not a factor. MONTEREY JAZZ sped to the early lead, opened a clear advantage past the wire the first time, widened the lead on the first turn and backstretch, continued clear leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. MEDICI CODE (GB) chased between rivals then inside and also weakened in the drive. CELTIC DREAMIN unhurried well off the rail into the first turn, angled in on the backstretch and was outrun.
