Footnotes

ONACCOUNTOFYOU angled to the inside in the run to the first turn, settled a bit off the rail, moved up outside a foe into and on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, surged to the front and pulled clear while drifting in a bit under some urging. BIMBO'S KISS unhurried outside a rival early, moved up outside a foe on the second turn, bid inside in the stretch, could not catch the winner but was game for second. TENFORTYBLUES pulled a bit along the inside stalking the early pace, came just off the inside leaving the first turn, bid outside the pacesetter and dueled into and on the second turn, was between foes into the stretch, also was no match for the winner and was edged for the place. SUMMER SPLENDOUR saved ground throughout chasing the pace and lacked the needed rally. WISHKA (NZ) bobbed a bit at the start, took the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and weakened. QUEEN OF KLUGS pulled her way along off the inside early, angled in and saved ground to no avail.
