Footnotes

CAME HOME stalked the early pace outside a rival, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead outside WERBLIN nearing the stretch and drew clear in the final furlong under a tap of the whip and a steady hand ride. EASY GRADES was in a good position chasing the leaders three deep then off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gained the place late. WERBLIN sprinted to the front a bit off the rail, dueled between horses midway on the backstretch and into the second turn, battled inside the winner leaving that turn, then was no match in the final furlong and just lost second. OCEAN SOUND (IRE) broke out a bit, angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, bid along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, fell back a bit leaving that bend and weakened some in the stretch. FONZ'S well placed chasing the leaders between horses then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PELIRROJO angled in unhurried early, went around a rival into the stretch, cut back to the inside and could not offer the necessary rally. COTTONWOOD COWBOY pulled his way along inside stalking the pace, dropped back into and on the second turn, came out in midstretch and weakened.
