Footnotes

MILWAUKEE BREW settled outside or off the rail, advanced outside on the second turn, split horses in upper stretch, bid outside in midstretch and pulled clear under urging. WESTERN PRIDE had good early speed and angled in, duelled outside a rival on the backstretch, shook loose again into the second turn, battled inside the winner in midstretch, then could not match that one and just held second. KUDOS broke outward, steadied when crowded early, settled outside, went five wide into the second turn and three deep into the stretch and just missed the place. GIANT GENTLEMAN angled in nearing the first turn, came off the rail to stalk the pace into the backstretch, continued outside a rival into the second turn, loomed a threat into the stretch but lacked the needed late response. CAGNEY (BRZ) unhurried inside early then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position in the stretch. IRISHEYESAREFLYING angled in approaching the first turn and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. FANCY AS stalked inside then went outside a rival nearing the second turn, continued toward the rail on that bend and weakened in the stretch. LAST PARADE (ARG) squeezed back at the start, settled three deep then outside a rival to the stretch and improved position some. SEINNE (CHI) unhurried inside early, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. FREEDOM CREST steadied when

crowded early, chased outside, went up four wide on the second turn and into the stretch but could not sustain the bid. DIG FOR IT chased in midpack outside, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. FUTURAL was in a good position stalking the leaders outside, also dropped back leaving the second turn and had little left. EUCHRE chased off the rail, began to drop back nearing the second turn, steadied early on that bend and gave way. SKY JACK drifted out onto foes early, angled in and pressed or stalked the pace along the inside, dropped back fast into and on the second turn and gave way readily.
