TEN MEROPA broke inward and slowly, settled off the rail, angled in some leaving the hill, came out in upper stretch, bid six wide in the drive to gain the lead past midstretch and proved best under some urging. SKY CAPE stalked between horses down the hill, bid between foes in the drive, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and was second best. D. DOUBLE YOU was in a good position tracking the pace inside, bid along the rail in the stretch and gamely edged a rival for third. NEVADA WORRIER stalked between horses, came three deep into the stretch, bid between rivals in midstretch and was edged for the show. RETURNING close up stalking the pace four wide down the hill, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DOC ON THE ROCK had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, stalked down the hill, came four wide into the stretch, re-bid five wide in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. SEA OF PLEASURE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away down the hill, fought back between foes in midstretch, then weakened. ITALIAN RULES between foes early, steadied at the right hand curve and dropped back, continued off the rail, was pulled up leaving the hill but walked off. Rail on hill at zero.
