SUGGESTIVE BOY (ARG) pulled and stalked outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead outside a foe, inched away under left handed urging in deep stretch and held on gamely. SILENTIO also pulled and stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch and finished well to just miss. FED BIZ close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, was between foes through much of the drive and just edged a rival for third. MR. COMMONS unhurried and angled to the inside early, saved ground off the pace, waited off heels leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch, was between horses in some traffic in midstretch then finished well late. FOREST MOUSE stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, bid between foes a quarter mile out, fought back inside in the stretch and was outfinished. AKKADIAN settled toward the inside then outside a rival on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished with interest. WILKINSON pulled and stalked outside a rival then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) had speed outside a rival then angled in and set the pace inside, fought back leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
