The field will be limited. Preference shall be given to the high weights based upon the weight assignments, adjusted for the sex allowance. Total earnings in 2000-2001 will be used in determining the preference of horses with equally assigned weights. 


Footnotes

TIZNOW angled in and dueled outside WOODEN PHONE, forged to the front in hand leaving the second turn, kicked clear into the stretch and proved best under some urging and steady handling. WOODEN PHONE had good early speed and dueled inside the winner on a short advantage, fought back when initially headed nearing the quarter pole, then was no match but second best. TRIBUNAL broke out and bumped a rival, angled in early and saved ground, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. IRISHEYESAREFLYING broke in a bit, stalked the dueling leaders a bit off the rail to the stretch and lacked the needed response. GUIDED TOUR was in a good position off the rail chasing the pace early, continued three deep on the backstretch and second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and could not offer the necessary rally. JIMMY Z between horses early, settled off the inside, came wide into the stretch and improved position. MOONLIGHT CHARGER close up chasing the leaders a bit off the rail, dropped back into and on

the second turn and weakened. BEAT ALL broke a bit slowly, settled off the inside, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. BIENAMADO bumped and stumbled badly after the start, settled outside and never rallied. PERSSONET (CHI) saved ground off the pace to the second turn, came out a bit on that bend and was not a factor. LETHAL INSTRUMENT bumped between foes at the start, settled off the inside chasing the pace, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. JORROCKS bumped and squeezed badly at the start, angled in and saved ground but was outrun.
