**Footnotes**

EXCLUSIVEANDCATTY took the early lead outside a rival and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled into the stretch, responded when headed in midstretch and gamely came back under urging. WARP settled a bit off the rail, was in a bit tight into the second turn then stuck behind horses on that bend, split rivals twice with a rally in the stretch and finished well. PROUD TAMMIE stalked the pace along the inside, bid outside the winner on the second turn, put a head in front in the stretch and just held third. ALINGA (IRE) three deep into the first turn, chased off the rail, fell back in a bit tight into the second turn, moved up between horses on that bend, came out in the stretch and was outfinished. DAZZLING DIAMONDS stalked the pace a bit off the rail, went up three deep on

the second turn and lacked the needed late kick. STEFANDREW angled in and pulled her way along inside stalking the pace, was shuffled a bit into the second turn, inched forward on that bend, remained inside and could not offer the necessary response. UP AT THE TOP (IRE) unhurried a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, improved position in the stretch. RAIN DANCER (NZ) moved up four wide early, stalked outside, inched forward on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. ARISTOSA pulled between horses then chased outside, was five wide into the second turn and also weakened. ANGEL SONG angled in and saved ground without early speed and failed to menace. RIVER BRIDGE (FR) bobbed at the start, went four wide on the first turn, chased six and seven wide on the backstretch, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. JEWEL MAGIC (NZ) angled in and saved ground unhurried early, went outside a rival on the second turn and was outrun.
