Footnotes

LIGACAO DIRETA (BRZ) stalked the pace inside, awaited room leaving the second turn, came out in upper stretch, bid alongside the runner-up and took the lead past the eighth pole, inched away under a tap of the whip and steady handling, drifted in late but proved best. POTION sent between foes to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, turned back a bid on the second turn to inch away again, battled inside the winner in midstretch, steadied when crowded in deep stretch and was second best. PLEASANT THUNDER lunged and was steadied at the start, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. SANDY SNEAKERS threw her head a bit at the start, chased outside a rival then off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. HONOR SPIRIT stalked the leader off the rail, bid outside that one on the backstretch and into the second turn, was between foes into the stretch and weakened. EMERALD SUNRISE chased along the inside, came off the rail on the second turn and did not rally.
