LAVA MAN stalked the pace outside then alongside a rival, bid three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched clear under urging past midstretch and held gamely. MOLENGAO (BRZ) hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, went three deep into the first turn, chased outside on the backstretch and second turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished well. BOBOMAN bumped lightly at the start, raced between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and went willingly to the end four wide on the wire. MCCANN'S MOJAVE washy in the hind quarters in the warmup, stalked outside then four wide into the first turn, continued outside on the backstretch and second turn, split horses into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award between foes late. SPRING AT LAST pulled his way along to stalk the early pace then bid alongside a foe on the first turn, dueled outside that one then between horses approaching and on the second turn, fought back to midstretch but weakened some in the final furlong. BALL FOUR took the early lead off the rail, angled in nearing the first turn, dueled inside, fought back into and on the second turn and to midstretch and also weakened in the final furlong. EL ROBLAR bumped at the start, was close up stalking the pace inside, came a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. AWESOME GEM broke out and bumped a rival, settled inside, went outside a foe leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response.
