THOMAS BAINES allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, split horses on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to be along in time. INDIAN FIREWATER stalked between horses then just off the rail, bid between rivals in deep stretch and continued willingly but could not quite match the winner. BULLDOGGER pulled his way to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, held on well in the drive but was overtaken late. DISTORTED DAVE broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled just off the rail then inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. GILLIGAN saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. MR. SATURDAYNIGHT was in a good position stalking the pace inside to the stretch and weakened some in the drive. TIMBAVATI pulled his way along wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then outside a rival, dropped back outside on the second turn and gave way.
