YOU LIFT ME UP chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to the lead outside foes in deep stretch and held gamely. EXQUISITE (NZ) forced in at the start, chased outside a rival, steadied behind the winner when coming out into the stretch, finished well four wide in deep stretch and between foes late. SHE'S CHEEKY angled in and stalked just off the rail then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid between foes in deep stretch then toward the inside late and continued willingly. VICTORYASECRET pulled her way along outside then dueled alongside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and also continued gamely late. CHASIN DREAMS settled outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and finished well four wide on the line. SKEDEE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened late. RESTLESS SOUL (GB) settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CENTURY PARK hopped and broke in onto a foe, angled in and settled inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and did not rally. MEYDAN PRINCESS (IRE) broke slowly and steadied when shut off, settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. EMPRESSIVE LADY stalked inside then a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference into the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
