STIRRED UP between horses early, settled inside then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival leaving the backstretch, moved up outside leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. HOLY CANDY stalked between foes then bid alongside a rival, took the lead into the stretch, fought back while drifting in through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS angled in early, prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked between foes, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, also drifted in late and bested the others. HUNTSVILLE pulled early, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, fought back on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. ANIMAUX DEL VIENTO saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch and weakened. UNMARKED BILLS steadied in tight early, stalked four wide then three deep on the backstretch and second turn, dropped back into the stretch, steadied again and came out off the heels of CAT'S ENOUGH in midstretch and was eased late. CAT'S ENOUGH broke a bit slow then bobbed just after the start, angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out some in the drive and broke down in midstretch.
