YES IT'S SNOWING dueled outside a rival, took the lead leaving the turn, drew clear under urging in the stretch and held. FORMAT V. unhurried off the rail early, went outside a rival into the turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and finished well. ERNIE OWL came out a bit at the start, stalked inside, angled off the rail on the turn and three wide into the stretch and picked up the show. HONOUR THE DEPUTY a bit slow to begin and squeezed a bit in the initial strides, stalked between foes then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. BLAKE had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn, weakened in the stretch. STREETS OF HEAVEN unhurried and angled in early, came a bit off the rail nearing the turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked a further response. DANGER RANGER stalked three deep, drifted out and dropped back on the turn, was pulled up into the stretch and walked off.
