Footnotes

WREKIN PILOT (GB) angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up into the stretch, split rivals past midstretch and rallied along the rail under some urging to get up late. KING OF SWING wearing nasal strip, was sent along to stalk the pace three deep, bid outside foes under urging leaving the hill, loomed up outside in the stretch, put a head in front late but was caught near the wire. FEARLESS PIRATE wearing a nasal strip, saved ground toward the inside off the early pace, came out crossing the dirt, split horses in midstretch and finished well. MR. RUSBRIDGE had good early speed and dueled outside a rival to the stretch, inched away nearing midstretch, fought back but was outfinished. BORROMINI pulled his way along between foes early and was in a bit tight at the right hand curve, continued outside down the hill and a bit wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. KING CRIMSON wearing a nasal strip, pulled his way along early, continued outside chasing the pace, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed late response. ONE MAN ARMY close up stalking the pace between horses early then outside a rival down the hill, also was between foes in midstretch and could not offer the necessary rally. JACK THE BULL wearing a nasal strip, settled off the rail unhurried, came out some for the stretch and was not a threat. COLONEL KELLY went up inside to duel on a short lead along the inside to upper stretch and weakened. CLASSIC RENOWN went up inside down the hill to track the dueling leaders but also weakened in the lane. I WONDER WHY angled in and settled toward the inside, was a bit crowded in midstretch and did not rally. PERCUTANT (GB) was slow into stride and settled outside down the hill, came a bit wide into the stretch and was outrun.
