Footnotes

SHEASTARGAZER sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, continued clear in the stretch and held on under urging. MISSIONAIRESS chased between horses on the backstretch and was in a bit tight into the turn, continued just off the rail on the bend, came out in upper stretch and gained the place. JEDS KNIGHT close up stalking the winner off the rail to the stretch, could not offer the needed response and just held third. DIXIE'S DREAM GIRL was well placed chasing the pace along the inside to the stretch and just missed the show. GENERALS MADAME off a bit slowly and awkwardly, settled outside a rival then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and also just missed third. BEL AIR BELLE also off slowly, was taken off the rail early, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. WINNER SEASON stalked the pace three deep on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, drifted out in the stretch and weakened. STATELY VIXEN was a bit crowded after the start, then was pulled up in the early stages and was vanned off.
