Footnotes

MILK IT MICK (GB) angled in and chased outside a rival then between foes, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes, took a short lead past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. ARAGORN (IRE) stalked inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and finished gamely between foes. CHINESE DRAGON unhurried inside early, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied between horses. CACIQUE (IRE) squeezed a bit at the start, settled outside then three deep, swung eight wide into the stretch and finished well. TERROPLANE (FR) allowed to settle toward the inside, swung out four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid. CHARMO (FR) chased outside then between foes, moved up leaving the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. WILLOW O WISP sped to the early lead, angled in and dueled inside, fought back gamely in the stretch and weakened some late. BUCKLAND MANOR came off the rail and pressed the pace outside a rival or between foes, battled between horses in the stretch and also weakened late. TOASTED saved ground chasing the pace, waited into the stretch then got through and lacked the needed rally. OSIDY chased inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SENOR SWINGER wide early, chased outside then between horses on the second turn, loomed a threat in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. DRUM MAJOR stalked four wide then three deep, continued four wide on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and weakened. GERONIMO (CHI) close up stalking the pace outside, bid

three deep on the backstretch, continued three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
