Footnotes

CARINI (GB) settled under the inside then outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch, angled out again in midstretch and closed gamely under urging to get up on the wire. PINDARIC stalked the pace inside, awaited room into the stretch, came out, split horses in midstretch, rallied to a short lead outside foes in deep stretch but was caught on the line. MANGO KISS saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside into the stretch and rallied willingly along the rail. SWEET DEE'S stalked the early pace inside, bid along the rail leaving the backstretch, dueled for command, inched away in midstretch and held on well between horses until late stretch then was outfinished. EARLY RONAN angled in and stalked outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. PAPILLON ROUGE (CHI) bobbled at the start, settled outside a rival to the stretch, moved up between foes through the drive but was outfinished. SANTIAGA (FR) angled in and chased outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, found the inside in the stretch but lacked the needed rally. BLUE ORCHID off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn

and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. STORMIN LUCY chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between foes into the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. RENA DE SONORA saved ground off the pace, remained inside and was not a threat. RULED BY NUMBERS stalked outside a rival then bid between foes leaving the backstretch, dueled between rivals on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. GRAND MISS sped to the early lead outside, set the pace off the rail, dueled three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, then also weakened.
