### Footnotes

CURIOSLY SWEET stalked the pace outside, came three deep into the stretch, gained the lead under urging in midstretch and pulled clear. SALAH MRS. D pulled her way to the front, set the pace inside, shook off a bid on the backstretch to clear into the second turn, could not match the winner in the final furlong but was clearly second best. SUMMER EVENT hree deep into the first turn, angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch and gained the show late. EXCESSIVE TALE stalked off the rail, angled to the inside in the stretch and was outfinished late for third. POKOMOKE unhurried inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. BARTOK'S BLING angled in and saved ground chasing the pace and lacked a response in the stretch. CATHRINE'S HOPE chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch, gave way and was eased. VIOLET BROOK four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, dropped back into the stretch, gave way and also was eased late. QUEEN OF THE DERBY broke in the air and slowly, settled toward the inside, went around a rival on the second turn and did not rally, then was not persevered with late. AUNT PINK stalked off the rail, bid outside the runner-up on the backstretch, dropped back between horses on the second turn, gave way readily and was eased in the stretch.
