**Footnotes**

RESPLENDENTLY stalked a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, surged to the front nearing midstretch, drew clear under urging, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. CAPTAIN BEAU between horses early, chased inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, came out when in tight off heels in upper stretch and gained the place. WARREN'S WAREHOUSE three deep into the first turn, settled outside a rival then inside on the second turn, continued along the rail in the stretch and got up late for the show. LEYVA MAN broke slowly, angled in and settled inside then came out into the backstretch, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed third. GREGOR pulled between horses to press the early pace then stalked just off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick between rivals late. UNUSUAL ENCOUNTER pulled four wide then three deep on the first turn, duelled outside a rival, was straightened and steadied midway on the backstretch, continued to battle for the lead to the stretch and weakened. JEFFREY'S GROOVE also pulled between horses then duelled inside, fought back on the second turn, weakened in the stretch and was between foes late. BRASS PLATE broke slowly, settled outside a rival to the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. MONEY INCLUDED between horses early, saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. REGAL FEVER pulled between rivals and steadied nearing the first turn, chased inside then just off the rail, was between foes again into the second turn, came out off heels in upper stretch and also weakened. HOSTILE WATERS saved ground off the pace, came outside a rival leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
