MR GRUFF pulled his way up between horses to duel for the lead, inched clear in the stretch and held gamely under urging. AIN'T NO OTHER prompted the pace three deep to the stretch then was coming back on at the winner late. PRESSDAY (AUS) went up inside to stalk the pace, came out a bit leaving the hill, split horses into the stretch and edged a rival for third. DANCING IN SILKS had good early speed and dueled inside, fell back some into the stretch, battled inside PRESSDAY in the final furlong and was edged for the show. MENSA HEAT five wide after the right hand curve, stalked outside then angled in, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MOBILIZED stalked four wide between horses, dropped back off the rail, angled to the inside into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SILVER SUMMATION was in a good position stalking the pace off the rail then between horses, continued bit off the fence leaving the hill, came out three deep into the stretch and also lacked the needed late kick. GIG HARBOR close up three deep between foes stalking the pace, continued outside a rival leaving the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
