Footnotes

DAVE'S PACEMAKER chased off the rail or outside a rival down the backstretch, moved closer around the turn, reached even terms with TRUMPET PLAYER JAY leaving the quarter pole, led into the lane and drew clear in the final furlong while drifting in. TRUMPET PLAYER JAY broke alertly and crossed over to take a clear early lead, maintained the advantage to the quarter pole, weakened down the lane but held the place. DANA DYNAMO was outrun down the backstretch and around the turn, swung widest of all in the stretch and passed tiring foes on the outside in the final sixteenth. PARTY MANDATE chased well off the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch three wide and lacked the necessary rally in the final furlong. SEVEN SECRETS moved up between horses to press the pace outside TRUMPET PLAYER JAY down the backstretch, began to weaken between horses nearing the quarter pole and fell back through the lane. HIGH STANDARDS chased on the inside throughout the journey and failed to make an impact in the lane. JUSTICE REIGNS stood in the gate and did not break with his field. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start for JUSTICE REIGNS and ruled his gate opened simultaneously with the rest of the field and declared him an official starter.
