RENEGADE STORM unhurried outside a rival then off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch then angled wider in upper stretch and rallied under some urging and good handling to be along in time. DONTMESROUNDWITJIM sped to the early lead, dueled inside then inched away, kicked clear on the

second turn and into the stretch and held on well but was overtaken late. ROARING TIMES angled in and stalked inside, came out into the stretch and bested the rest. LODI RED chased three deep or outside a rival, continued outside on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. KALOOKAN STORM three wide early, chased outside a rival, split horses on the backstretch and into the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WARREN'S KONG allowed to settle along the inside, saved ground off the pace to the stretch and was not a threat. SHORT MEMO stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn and weakened. MARK THE BENCH chased outside or off the rail, came out leaving the second turn, was in a bit tight off heels four wide into the stretch and weakened. LE' HEAT angled in early and saved ground throughout to no avail. EXCELLING prompted the pace outside the runner-up then stalked off the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened.
