Footnotes

LUTESS stalked the pace outside, ranged up leaving the turn to gain the lead into the stretch, kicked clear and proved best under a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. L'ENCHANTERESSE (IRE) stalked off the rail or outside a rival, split horses in midstretch and gained the place. IMPERATRIZ four wide early, stalked three deep, came out into the stretch and bested the others. MORNING FROST chased between horses then outside, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FUNKY SOUP sent between horses early, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, fought back into the stretch and weakened. CHASE THE FEVER settled between foes then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and was not a threat. PIVOTAL QUEEN (IRE) dropped back a bit off the rail early then went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EMBA U. T. K. chased just off the rail, went between horses into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BILLSSECONDCHANCE bobbled at the start, saved ground throughout and was not a factor. SIGN IN between horses early, angled in and stalked inside, fell back leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
