EXCLAMATION (GB) had good early speed, and dueled between horses then outside a rival, battled off the rail leaving the hill, inched clear into the stretch, drifted out in the drive but held gamely under urging. Mенса HEAT chased between horses then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and finished well. PACK YOUR BAGS stalked four wide then outside on the hill, came three deep into the stretch and edged rivals for third between foes late. GALLETA MONSTRUO broke alertly then dropped back off the rail, trailed to the stretch, came four wide into the lane and found his best stride widest on the line. MAJESTIC DIAMOND (NZ) prompted the pace inside then stalked a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. LEANDROS (FR) prompted the pace three deep then outside the winner, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened some. KING LEDLEY pulled between horses and steadied at the right hand curve, chased outside a rival down the hill, was between horses into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MICHAEL THE MAN also pulled between horses then chased off the rail, angled in leaving the hill and lacked the needed rally. FANDINO bobbed at the start, pulled outside then alongside a rival down the hill, came out into the stretch, angled inward and split horses in the drive and

was outfinished. BLAME THE JOCKEY broke a bit slowly, pulled just off the rail then angled in and saved ground on the hill and into the stretch and did not rally. TAKE A HARD LOOK settled a bit off the rail then between horses, continued outside a rival down the hill, came out into the stretch, drifted inward in the final furlong and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
