### Footnotes

LORD SMITH (GB) settled a bit off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn and took a short lead nearing the stretch, responded when briefly headed and brushed by HAWKSLEY HILL in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. HAWKSLEY HILL (IRE) settled between horses, moved up three deep into and on the second turn, put a head in front outside the winner and brushed that one in deep stretch and continued willingly to just miss. LADIES DIN, saved ground, waited off heels on the second turn then split rivals leaving that bend, split foes again in upper stretch and bid inside in midstretch but could not match the top pair. COMMITISIZE dueled outside FABULOUS GUY, battled inside the winner leaving the second turn but weakened in the stretch. TRIDENT, three deep early, continued outside, angled in for the second turn and did not rally. FABULOUS GUY (IRE) pulled his way to a slim early lead, dueled inside COMMITISIZE until leaving the second turn and weakened.
