EMERALD DIXIE chased off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to prove narrowly best. BELONGSTOSPEED pulled her way to the early lead then stalked along the inside, waited leaving the second turn, got through in the stretch and took a short advantage past the eighth pole, drifted out despite right handed urging and could not quite hold off the winner. BOB'S LADY a bit crowded at the start, made a move four and five wide on the backstretch, continued three deep into the stretch, took a short lead outside in midstretch but settled for the show. ALYSTONE LANE three deep early, went up outside the leader to press the pace, continued between horses on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and lacked a further response. THERMAL ABLASION broke slowly, went up outside a rival to the lead on the first turn, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, inched away briefly leaving the second turn, battled between horses in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. FANCY BEGINING a bit crowded at the start, saved ground while lagging back without early speed, made up some ground in the stretch but was not a threat. HIGH HUMIDITY stumbled to her nose at the start, came off the rail leaving the first turn, bid four wide between horses on the backstretch, continued between foes on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened.
