Footnotes

BELLA VOLARE angled in and settled outside a rival then off the rail, split horses leaving the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, took a short lead and proved best under urging. CANTALOUPE between horses early, dueled inside but a bit off the rail, inched away on the second turn, fought back inside the winner through the stretch but could not quite match that one. CHARLIES GOOD GIRL four wide into the first turn, angled in nearing the backstretch and stalked inside, moved up menacingly along the rail leaving the second turn but could not sustain the bid. BITINGLY COLD saved ground stalking the early pace, came out on the backstretch, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. GO RUBY GO sent three deep early, went between horses to vie for command on the first turn, momentarily put a head in front on the backstretch outside the winner, fell back some leaving the second turn and gave way. MAGICAL NATURE (IRE) angled in early and saved ground to no avail. BYE BYE BIRDIE broke in a bit, raced off the rail early then dueled three deep leaving the first turn and on the backstretch, dropped back into and on the second turn and had little left.
