**Footnotes**

FIRE BOLT (BRZ) went up three deep between horses to duel for the lead, battled between foes on the turn and a bit off the rail in midstretch, gained a short lead and held on gamely under urging. SIPHON HONEY hopped in the air in a slow start, went up outside a rival then pressed the pace inside, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn, angled back to the inside in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. GIVE ME SUGAR broke slowly, settled inside, swung four wide into the stretch and gained the show. SWEET FITZ (ARG) prompted the pace four wide then three deep into and on the turn, gained a slim advantage in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. CHAMP'S ROCKET unhurried off the rail then outside a rival into the turn, came out five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LADY SABRINA chased a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the stretch and failed to menace. DOMINIQUES DARLING stalked the dueling leaders outside a rival on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. IT WAS MEANT TO BE (GB) chased off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, lacked room off heels into the stretch, got through along the rail in the drive but lacked the necessary response. DIXIE DOS had good early speed off the rail then dueled between horses, angled in and fought back on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and gave way.
