STREET BOSS stalked outside then four wide leaving the backstretch and into the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under a tap of the whip and a brisk hand ride while drifting in. PAUL'S HOPE sped between horses to the early lead, inched away and set the pace off the rail, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. TEMECULA CREEK stalked outside a rival or between horses, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival for third. CARRILERO (ARG) was in a good position stalking the pace a bit off the rail then between horses nearing the turn, continued just off the inside on the turn and into the stretch and was edged late for the show. SAVE chased outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch and turn and lacked the needed rally. CIGAR PAL broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. VESPUCCI also a bit slow to begin, chased inside then a bit off the rail and did not rally. STORM MACHINE (ARG) had speed inside then stalked along the rail to the stretch and weakened.
