FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each to accompany the nomination. Closed with 31. \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$5,000 to start with \$750,000 guaranteed, of which \$450,000 to first, \$150,000 to second, \$90,000 to third, \$45,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. The field will be limited to 14 starters. Preference shall be given to the high weights based upon the weight assignments, adjusted for the sex allowance. Total earnings in 2009-10 will be used in determining the preference of horses with equally assigned weights. No horse shall be assigned more than 126 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, breeder, trainer, and jockey.

MISREMEMBERED stalked outside then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, took a short lead, inched away in the stretch, kicked clear and held under urging. NEKO BAY unhurried inside early, split horses nearing the stretch and again in midstretch, angled in some and rallied inside the winner. DAKOTA PHONE angled in and stalked just off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, loomed a threat behind the winner in midstretch, could not match the top pair but bested the rest. JERANIMO wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival, split

horses leaving the second turn and could not offer the necessary late kick. RENDEZVOUS chased inside, came out into and on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ST TRINIANS (GB) saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. MARSH SIDE pulled his way along off the rail then angled in through the stretch the first time, came out into the backstretch and stalked off the rail, was three deep into the stretch and weakened. DELIGHTFUL KISS unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and improved position some. PICK SIX settled off the pace inside, came out into and on the second turn, swung five wide into the stretch and did not rally. POOL PLAY allowed to settle outside then three deep, also came out five wide into the stretch failed to menace. LOUP BRETON (IRE) chased between horses, angled out on the second turn, swung six wide into the stretch and was not a factor. TIGER'S ROCK angled in through the stretch and bumped with a rival early, chased inside, came out in midstretch and weakened. EAGLE POISE angled in and pulled his way along inside, bumped with a rival in tight nearing the wire the first time, came out into the clubhouse turn, chased outside, angled four wide into the stretch and also weakened. MAST TRACK hustled along to the early lead off the rail then angled in, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
