KRAKOW QUEEN had good early speed and dueled inside, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under urging. POETIC RICHES chased outside then between foes, moved up three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a rival for second. DIVA GONE WILD was a bit slow into stride and steadied when squeezed early, chased just off the inside, went around a rival into the stretch, came out some in the drive and just missed the place. IF YOU

KNEW SUSIE chased outside then four wide, angled in and split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. R. C. STORM stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. GIRLWITHEGOLDHOOF prompted the pace outside the winner then between foes on the turn and also weakened. CARAT FOR C. C. hopped a bit at the start, chased just off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SUMALEE chased outside or between horses, angled in on the turn and weakened in the stretch. TONKA T. allowed to settle outside then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was not a threat. BINKY'S SISTER broke slowly and was bumped, settled just off the rail, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. HORCHATA wide early, chased outside or off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and did not rally. EARLY HABIT chased off the rail then a bit off the fence, angled to the inside on the turn and lacked a further response. BILLSSECONDCHANCE broke out and bumped a rival in a slow start, moved up inside on the backstretch, steadied in tight into the turn to drop back and had little left for the stretch.
