YET ANOTHERNATALIE stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, ranged up four wide into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch and drove clear under a moderate hand ride. BELLESKI had good early speed a bit off the rail, dueled between horses into and on the turn, battled inside the winner in midstretch, then could not match strides but held second. BUTTERCUP'S SONG off a bit slowly, went up inside to press the pace, then weakened in the stretch. AFFAIRS OF STATE prompted the pace outside on the backstretch and four wide into and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. WILSHEWED sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled between horses into and on the turn, dropped back past midway on the bend and gave way.
