MARKET GARDEN cut the corner at the right hand curve then angled in and dueled outside a rival, inched away leaving the hill, kicked clear into the stretch and held on gamely inside. CARLA ROSE stalked the pace a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and closed willingly. ANIMA MUNDI (IRE) chased between horses then outside a rival, continued outside a foe into the stretch and bested the rest. ROWAN EXPRESS (GB) chased between horses then alongside a foe, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. DREAM DAY stalked inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. POTRI STAR (ARG) steadied at the right hand curve, chased outside, came five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. TANGARA (NZ) saved ground off the pace and lacked the needed rally. A SMILE PER MILE had speed between horses then dueled inside the winner, dropped back into the stretch and weakened, did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. TYVARA stalked outside early, dropped back on the hill and weakened. SIRACOQUE off a bit

awkwardly, dropped back, raced wide down the hill, angled in some and did not rally. ACURE FOR GERI off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace and was outrun.
