Footnotes

STARDOM BOUND unhurried inside then off the rail, went outside a rival on the backstretch, continued four wide leaving the second turn and six wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up outside foes on the line. THIRD DAWN settled outside a rival, split horses on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied outside and was bumped in deep stretch then went between foes late. HOOH WHY prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked off the rail, re-bid on the second turn to gain the lead, inched away in the stretch, drifted out a bit to bump with a rival in deep stretch and continued gamely between horses late. NAN settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the second turn, angled out into the stretch, waited off heels when boxed in passing midstretch, angled in, split foes and finished with interest inside. BURG BERG had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, fought back on the second turn and again past midstretch and was outfinished late. BELTENE chased three deep on the first turn then outside, went three wide again on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. MISS SILVER BROOK a bit slow to begin, chased inside, came out into the stretch, bid between foes and was bumped and steadied in deep stretch and was outfinished. STORMY SLEW stalked off the rail, dropped back between horses on the second turn and weakened. WILL O WAY chased outside then off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and also weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the bumping in deep stretch but made no change when they ruled all runners involved contributed to the contact.
