Footnotes

FLUXX chased on the inside down the backstretch and inside a rival around the second turn, swung out at the top of the stretch, gradually wore down the leader inside the sixteenth pole and prevailed. FRECKLES GALORE saved ground around the first turn, stalked outside the pacesetter down the backstretch, bid for the lead on the second turn, took command at the top of the lane, drifted out slightly through the final furlong and was caught in deep stretch. SINGMEASONG (GB) was off a bit slowly, chased on the outside down the backstretch, angled over to save some ground around the second turn, came out at the top of the lane, angled back to the rail in deep stretch and was a clear third at the wire. THE DOLL ROOM sped to the lead out of the gate and crossed over into the first turn, inched clear down the backstretch, was challenged for command on the second turn and weakened on the inside in the lane. CLEARLY CASUAL chased on the outside down the backstretch and outside the winner around the second turn, remained off the rail in the lane and also weakened. MS. SWEET FREEDOM was taken in hand between horses early, angled to the rail into the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch and was pulled up approaching the second turn and vanned off.
